The following curriculum guide is for Saint Alcuin Classical Academy Academic Program students. Enrichment only students will follow the sections under the Enrichment headings. Our curriculum follows a three-year cycle of classes for each House so that student entering and leaving each year will not duplicate content. The exceptions will be arts and disciplines that build upon each other, such as Arithmetic & Mathematics. Students will work with Tutors independently on such subjects and not as a whole House class.

They also discover that words are symbols representing ideas, and as writers they can communicate the same idea using a variety of words and sentence structures.

Students learn to demonstrate the truth of the Commonplace through what the ancient Greek writer Aphthonius calls "eight heads of development," and students deal more explicitly and thoroughly with what in modern composition theory are referred to as "support points." The ability to invent four specific types of narrative through these "heads of development" and to paraphrase in two specific ways are the foundational skills to be learned in this stage.

Newton's Laws of Motion and his Laws of Universal Gravitation are presented to give students an understanding of the forces that shape the planet. Earth's internal structure and Tectonic Plate Theory, as well as landforms, soil, saltwater, and freshwater are investigated. Other topics include atmosphere, the biosphere, weather, and climate. Extreme weather and natural events, and unusual landforms are sure to attract student interest. The book closes with a look at how populations meet their energy needs and discusses responsible stewardship of the environment.
- Space Science: For the space science course at St. Alcuin, we will present both the scientific arguments for the heliocentric and the Modern geocentric models of the solar system. The Michaelmas term will cover the Seton textbook and the Candlemas term will cover selections from the Geocentrism 101 text. A separate answer key will also need to be purchased.

• The other branch of logic study was called "material logic," and focused not on the form of reasoning, but on its content. In short, while formal logic studied the "how" of reasoning, material logic studied the "what." The principles of material logic, an important part of trivium language study, are now almost forgotten—a casualty of the almost exclusive modern secular emphasis on math and sciences. Formal logic was once termed minor (or lesser) logic, while material logic usually went by the name of major (or greater) logic—a measure of how important classical thinkers considered them.

The answers to these fundamental questions come primarily from the great minds Aristotle and St. Thomas Aquinas.

He provides guidelines for composing and analyzing music, including the use of symmetry and proportion.

Using the Five Canons of Rhetoric developed by Aristotle's pupils Theophrastus and Demetrius and refined by Cicero, students will develop their thesis consisting of 20-30 typed double-spaced pages using the Chicago Manual of Style with the following elements: (1.) introduction (*exordium*), (2.) statement of facts (*narratio*), (3.) thesis statement (*partitio*), (4.) argument (*confirmatio*), (5.) counterargument (*refutatio*), and (6.) conclusion (*peroratio*). Students will defend their thesis before a panel of judges and later present a 1,000 word oration to the Saint Alcuin community to persuade the audience to their viewpoint.
