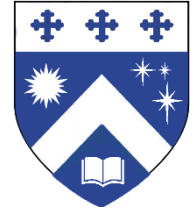


Saint Alcuin Classical Academy Curriculum Map



The following is an example of a typical curricular path for a St. Alcuin Academy homeschool student. We are partnering with the Classical Liberal Arts Academy to deliver the core curriculum online to our students and assess their learning. St. Alcuin will supplement the CLAA with face-to-face courses at the parish. Please check with local or state government for specific subject requirements for homeschool students. Most states require the following each academic year: Mathematics, English Language Arts, Science, Social Studies, and Reading.
